The head-dress pictured is a charming reproduction of Egyptian art.

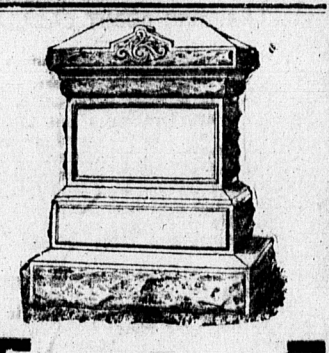
