THOMAS J. Dillon of St. John, N.B. is superintendent of the dairy building. He is a pioneer in the cheese business, having been manufacturing for some 30 years. In 1883-4 he was exhibiting cheese here and taking first prizes. He observed to The World yesterday: "The average quality is better this year than last. I recall that we had some 36 exhibitors in 1883, with some 108 entries. To-day this number has reached the enormous proportions of 500 entries, representing some 240 different exhibitors. There are few inferior articles shown here. There is nothing shown west of Winnipeg, but all the balance of Canada is here. The cheese shown here are worth some \$4000. It is said nothing but inferior cheese is sold at home. Of course, the best is usually exported for it is a business proposition, and the best goods go to the highest bidders, but there is much of the superior article sold in Canada. This stuff brings about 11 cents a pound wholesale, but Canada produces much fancy cheese that brings 50 cents on the open market. There are 150 entries in butter, and the grade is steadily improving. The cheese industry has made more rapid progress than the art of butter making." - Toronto World.
