Therefore the much promised Tunnel Survey should be made at once. In that regard no question of route can arise.

The Ottawa correspondent of the London Standard of Empire sums up the attitude of the Canadian people towards reciprocity in two sentences as follows: "There is no gainsaying the fact that the financial and industrial interests of the Dominion are, as a whole, still strongly opposed to the agreement."
