

First Vote Period Ends To-Night

ALL Candidates May Work Up to 7 O'clock TO-NIGHT

To Secure the First Period Votes All Candidates Allowed to Work Up to 7 O'clock To-Night.

Rules for the Close of the First Vote Period

1. The first vote-period in the big prize Contest closes at 7 o'clock Saturday night.
2. All candidates (both city and out-of-town) may work up to the last minute of the first vote-period.
3. The office of the Contest Department at 163 Great George St., will be open until 8 o'clock Saturday evening to receive subscriptions and issue votes for the convenience of city candidates.
4. City candidates who are unable to get to the Contest Department by the above hour may mail their results and they will be given votes as per the first vote-schedule, provided their letters reach us on the first delivery of mail Monday morning.
5. Out-of-town candidates may work up to 7 o'clock Saturday night, also, and then mail their results at the first opportunity. All letters must bear the post-mark of July 24th., if possible. We will make due allowance for the late arrival of mail from candidates living on lines where mail does not leave until Monday morning.
6. New candidates who have not time to send for supplies may list out their subscribers on a sheet of paper and send them to the contest Dept. with sufficient remittance to cover them. Other candidates who run out of supplies may do likewise. Do not let anything cause you to lose out on the first period votes.
7. City candidates who call at the contest department Saturday night should have their middle receipt forms fully filled out before presenting them, otherwise they will lose their turns of being waited upon.
8. Keep your subscription forms in numerical order and thus assist the Contest assistants.
