LET THE CITY PROVIDE A SPEEDWAY.

Prince Edward Island has been considerably noted for its production of good horses, and amongst them not a few of highly creditable speed such as attract horse lovers.

Few other animals so intelligently and heartily enter into the spirit of their master, man, whether in work or play or the stern shock of battle. The high mettled charger enjoys a gallop with his master or mistress on his back.

But this by the way. If we are to have horses, at their best in speed and value we must have a place to train them and develop their speed. Charlottetown needs a speedway and

it should and can be provided, quite easily and at very moderate cost, and in a most convenient locality. Horse speeding on the public roads or the Park Roadway is properly objected to as an inconvenience and a source of fear and danger to pedestrians or leisurely-going carriage folk.

Let a speedway be constructed along the north side of Victoria Park, immediately south of and parallel to the Brighton Road but separated from it. This location would leave the Park and its drives, its main entrances east and west free and open and not in any way interfered with.

A speedway constructed as suggested at Brighton would be a joy to horsemen, as well as valuable to them. It would be also a good civic asset. It would attract visitors. It would add to the attractions of the Park for all lovers of horseflesh and equestrian sport.

AN IMPORTANT INDUSTRY.

Prince Edward Island has comparatively few manufacturing industries but it has some good ones of more than provincial importance. It is obvious that one of the prime needs of a City and Province such as ours is manufacturing industries that give employment during the whole year, and especially during the winter season.

Our larger and better industries do more than this when they sell their products in considerable part beyond the Straits, in that case bringing money from abroad to be expended here. Such industries are invaluable for increasing the home market, preventing the migration of our people abroad, increasing the wealth of the community, giving added impetus to trade and in more ways than can be here set down increasing the general welfare and content of the country at large.

Such an industry is that of the Bruce Stewart Company whose annual meeting was recently held at the close of a successful and prosperous year. The establishment of this company may be said to have grown with the growth and strengthened with the strength of the city.

Such industries are not only of great advantage to the City and Province but for that reason and because they pay good dividends on invested capital should be encouraged in every way. One successful industry such as this ought to be the fruitful parent of others by demonstrating that manufacturing can be carried on here quite as successfully as in other towns throughout Canada which have been built up in this way.

A THIRTY MILLION SURPLUS.

It is given out from Ottawa that during the eleven months of Canada's current financial year, ended with February, the revenue has exceeded 104 millions, being 14 millions greater than for the like period of last year, and nearly three millions more than the revenue of the twelve months of last year.

The Toronto Globe intimates that the revenue for the year may be sufficient to pay all the ordinary expenditure of the year, with the capital expenditure and the larger moiety of the outlay made during the year on the Transcontinental Railway. If these expectations are realized it will be a really marvellous result.

QUEBEC, March 5.—Speaking before a crowded meeting of a non-political character in this city last night, Prof. Leacock, of McGill University, denounced the reciprocity treaty. The attempt of a few men to force this fiscal resolution upon the Canadian people by a sheer executive act, was, he said, the worst possible distortion of democratic government.

Dwelling upon all the struggles of the past to build up a strong Canadian nationhood, the speaker urged his hearers not to take a false step now that they were so near to the goal of their empire, Quebec, the birthplace of Canada, would feel the change more than any other part if they had to throw in their lot with the United States.
