BOIS, IDAHO, June 17.—During the Haywood trial Saturday the examination of Major Naylor of the militia, Richardson next attempted to show that as major of militia Naylor took all of his orders from the Mine Owners Association, but the witness declared he knew of no orders coming from the association at any time. Former Governor Peabody entered the court room while Major Naylor was under cross-examination. He was accompanied by his wife and daughter. 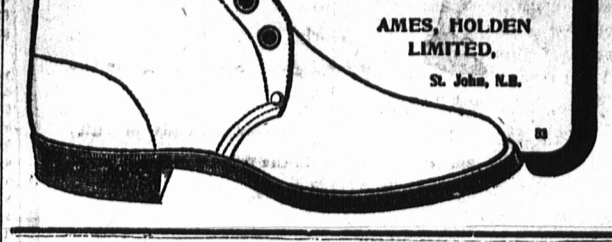
