Tea-Party At Rollo Bay

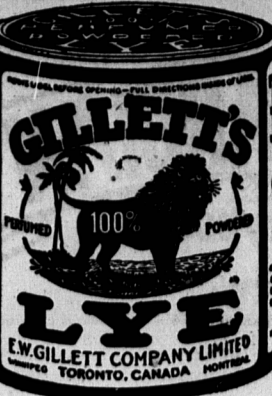
