Boy Saves Baby Brother From Mystery Murderers

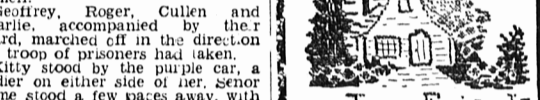

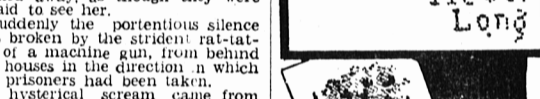
