In Memoriam

MISS BERNADETTE MULLIGAN

It is with deep regret and a grave sense of personal loss that I take my pen to chronicle the death of the late Bernadette Mulligan, youngest daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John T. Mulligan of Kinkora, whose death took place in the Prince County Hospital on Saturday, February 14th.

Death is always sad and ever leaves in its train its complement of sorrowing and broken hearts; but it is doubly so in a case such as this. In but her twenty-first year, in the flower of youth, Bernadette was, in a sense like a flower-sweet, young and tender, reaching out into the pure sunshine in the spring time of life. It has been said that God plucks the choicest flowers to adorn and beautify His heavenly garden while those less worthy are left to combat the elements here below in the "valley of tears."

Bernadette was of a sweet and loving disposition and was possessed of that charming manner which instantaneously attracts one to her. To know her was to admire her, and to be infected by her generous and friendly personality. She consequently was very popular not only with the younger set, who were her childhood and school companions but the older folk as well—and the little children too all felt the touch of her simple and truly friendly nature. Although she had never been in robust health Bernadette was yet able to enjoy the usual pleasures and pastimes of youth. She loved to meet up with her many friends at dances, concerts or any other friendly gatherings and was ever the life of the party. She will be sadly missed at all such social functions of her many friends and acquaintances; but it is in the home where she will be especially missed. The youngest of the family, and the fact that she had always been considered delicate, possibly made her a special favorite with each and every member of the family. Time will no doubt help to heal the grief-stricken hearts of her parents, brothers and sister; but there will ever be that vacant longing and deep sense of loss which time can never fully erase.

On Tuesday morning, February 17th, the funeral, which was very largely attended, was held from the home of her father to St. Malachias Church, Kinkora and was under the direction of Mr. Philip Monaghan, assisted by Mr. Raymond Kelly. The pallbearers were her six brothers, Joseph, Linus, John Emmett, Everett, Keith and Preston. As the casket entered the church it was met by the pastor Rev. Fr. McQuaid. Members of the Sodality of our Lady (of which the deceased was a member) flanked the main aisle and slowly marched behind the casket up to the altar. Requiem High Mass was sung by the pastor, Fr. McQuaid while Fr. Keefe P.P. of Kelly's Cross was also present in the sanctuary. After mass the sorrowing procession slowly moved to the adjoining cemetery where the committal service was chanted by Fr. McQuaid.

Besides her sorrowing parents there are left to mourn the loss of a loving sister and daughter, her brothers: Joseph, Linus, John Emmett, Everett, Keith and Preston. Also one sister, Helen. Eternal rest grant unto her, O Lord, May she rest in Peace, Amen.
