A. of the Presbyterian College Halifax, who has been appointed by the Presbyterian Volunteer Union for Foreign Missions to visit congregations in the Maritime Provinces and to assist ministers in arousing and strengthening interest in Foreign Missions is now in Cape Breton. In addition to presenting the claims of Missions, Mr. Myers will endeavor where desirable and practicable to organize missionary committees or societies, such as the W. F. M. S. and mission bands, and also to encourage the founding of small missionary libraries. (Mr. Myers is a native of Lake Verde P. E. I., and has labored on the Island during part of this and last summer in behalf of Foreign Missions.)
