In Montague yesterday dealers were paying forty-two cents a bushel for oats, twenty-two to twenty-five cents a bushel for potatoes; sixteen cents a dozen for eggs, ten and a half cents a pound for pork, twenty-two cents a pound for butter and ten cents a pound for hides.

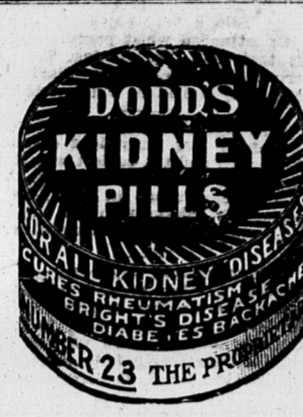

OBITUARY.

The death occurred at San Francisco, Cal., March 1st, 1910, of Emmanuel Campbell, son of the late Ronald Campbell, and brother of John R. Campbell, clerk of the County Court of Kings Co., Dundas, P. E. Island, leaving a wife and one son, who is a college graduate, and two brothers, besides a very wide circle of friends to mourn their loss.

He was older, he did not depart from his principles, inculcated in his mind in early years. He received a very liberal education, was an unusually good penman. But his forte was in mathematics. He was among the very few known in a common school who could work out "Thomson's Logarithms". He left home over thirty years ago, with a determination to succeed, and his hopes were realized. He was superintendent of Streets for the city, for a long period and his services were duly appreciated, as well also in other departments of the public service. He has left behind in his native land a host of warm friends, who will be very sorry to hear of his early demise. But "We all do pass that way and there is none abiding." He has left behind him the record of an honorable career and of a pure life.
