**CHANGING TIMES.**—An elderly gentleman of Southport recalls the fact that on May 5th, 63 years ago, he crossed on the ice from Southport to Charlottetown. Old as he is he could not do it today.

**SUCCESSFUL.**—In the results of the examinations in the second year in Applied Science, at McGill University, the name of Mr. Hammond Johnson, city, appears as follows: Class I—Phys. Laboratory, 3rd. Class II—Viraphical Statics; mapping; Mechanical Drawing; 1st. Class III—Mechanics of Machines; Surveying; Calculus, 2nd.

**MARINE AND FISHERIES.**—The government ice-breaker, Earl Grey, says the Halifax Herald, will be ten days longer in the drydock during the effecting of her annual overhauling. In another month the Minto, with which she has been working on mail ferry service between the mainland and Prince Edward Island, will come to Halifax to fit out for a season's survey work in Hudson Bay. She is now undergoing repairs at Pictou. As there is considerable work left undone in this district for the Montserrat she will remain for several weeks longer before proceeding to Quebec to resume her service on that station.

**THE LATE MRS. HORNE.**—The death of Mrs. Frederick H. Horne occurred in Charlottetown on Saturday evening last. The deceased was a daughter of the late Mr. Charles Heartz and was born at North River in December 1842. In 1866 she was married to Mr. F. H. Horne and they lived at Winslow till nearly three years ago, when they moved to Charlottetown. The late Mrs. Horne was an invalid for over thirty years and notwithstanding her great suffering from spinal trouble she was always patient and kind and set a good example of Christian fortitude. Besides her husband, she leaves to mourn her loss three daughters—Mrs. I. Holman and Mrs. A. Taper, Charlottetown, and Mrs. R. B. McMillan, Brackley Point Road; also three sisters, Mrs. A. Duffy, Charlottetown; Mrs. H. G. Watts, and Mrs. J. J. Seaman, Denver, Col., and six brothers—Frederick in Pictou, N. S.; James, John and William in Denver and David and Charles in New York. The funeral takes place to-day at 3 p.m. from the family residence, 257 Queen St. to Milton cemetery.

**AGRICULTURAL MEETING.**—On Friday evening a meeting of the Clyde River Institute was held at New Haven. It was very largely attended, over one hundred being present. Prof. Ross was present and spoke of the work to be undertaken by the Institute and also of the re-organization that have taken place and new Institutes being formed. He congratulated the New Haven people on so many of them joining and thought that Clyde River Institute would be one of the most progressive in the Province. He spoke of the work that had been done by the Kingston branch of it in carrying the institute through the time of difficulty and in having a membership from that part alone of over seventy.

He then spoke of the work that is being done by the Department of Agriculture along its several lines. Women's Institutes are being encouraged and Miss Katherine James of Charlottetown has been appointed to take special charge of this end of the work. Miss James will be glad to meet the women of any school district to discuss the organization of Women's Institutes with them at any time. He spoke of the Sheep Dipping Demonstrations that would be undertaken this summer and of the Live Stock Judging classes. Quite a lot of questions were asked in regard to the treatment of grain for smut; the best method of seeding and of applying manure, etc., etc. Prof. Ross said that nearly all of these subjects were treated at length in pamphlets which could be had from the Department of Agriculture for the asking. A vote of thanks was moved by Mr. Crews of Kingston and carried unanimously. Before the meeting adjourned the question of automobiles came for consideration, and a resolution was carried disapproving of allowing automobiles to run on the country roads of Prince Edward Island. There were four present voted against the resolution.

A spark from a flue set the prairie ablaze and a barn belonging to Mr. Henderson and three horses, three bulls, 1,500 sheaves of oats, new truck wagon and a lot of other things owned by the three, were totally lost. It is a serious set back for the boys but they are not disheartened and hope soon to recover the loss.

**EARNSCLIFFE.**—Mrs. John McKinnon has been very ill during the past week, also Mrs. Henry Young's baby.—Mr. Harry Tweedy is having some improvements made in his dwelling house. The work is being done by a master workman, Mr. James Crane.—The freshets this spring made fierce havoc with the road leading from the Loyalist road to Western Earncliffe. Two weeks ago today the road master started to repair it, and Saturday evening following Mr. Praught and his men had a fine job completed. Mr. Praught is one of the best road masters in the province. In connection with the work on this road it might be added that the kindness and hospitality shown the men engaged in the work by our Post Mistress, Mrs. Doyle and her sons, was much appreciated and will not be soon forgotten.—The people in this locality are strongly opposed to the auto repeal act. The city friends are making a mistake in fighting against the farmers in this matter. Time will tell which force is the stronger.
