**NEW YORK, Nov. 22**—The French franc, at present selling well below the figure at which it is profitable to ship gold from the country, showed a further decline in the foreign exchange markets here today, closing at 6.58 1-4 cents for a loss of .00 1-8 of a cent.  
The pound sterling was up 3-8 at \$4.93 3-8, a new high since Sept 18. Much of the money leaving France is being converted into sterling. The Canadian dollar was quoted at a discount of 31-32 of one per cent, the first time it has gone above one per cent discount since Nov. 4. Yesterday's quotation was 1-32 per cent.

**MONTREAL, Nov. 22**—Little change was noted in prices on Montreal open produce market today with prices holding close to previous quotations.  
Eggs ruled at the week's decline with graded shipments in cartons or less selling at 36 to 37 cents a dozen for A-large, 32 to 34 for A-medium, 30 to 32 for A-pullets, 25 1-2 to 28 for B and 24 for C.  
Butter was quiet and unchanged at 26 to 28 1-4 cents per pound for cartons or less of no 1 white lots to the retail trade were 27 cents for solids and 28 for prints.  
Cheese was 10 3-4 to 11 cents per pound for current arrivals of no 1 Ontario.  
Potatoes held unchanged at \$1.40 to \$1.45 for Prince Edward Island mountains and \$1.35 to \$1.40 for cobbler, per 90-pound bag. In 80-pound bags, Prince Edward Island mountains were \$1.25 to \$1.30, cobbler \$1.20 to \$1.25. New Brunswick white mountains \$1.25 to \$1.30, Quebec mountains \$1.10 to \$1.15 and Quebec white no 2 stock 90 cents to \$1.10.

## MINING

**TORONTO, Nov. 22**—Mining share prices were only mildly disturbed today by the wave of selling and price cutting on the industrial share markets. When the weak spell set in the mining board had already accumulated substantial collection of good gains and these were utilized to cushion the fall that came along in the last hour. Net recessions held within a point. The gold index registered a loss of 31 to 111.31 and miscellaneous mines 45 to 106.32. Turnover was heavy at \$22,000 shares.  
Dome Mines closed at 42 for broken lots, off 7-8 while McIntyre merely lost its early gain of 3-4. Eralonia weakened 15 cents. In the early part of the session the base metal stocks joined in a strong advance. Noranda touched a new high at 45.  
From a strong start the silvers turned heavy and closed with Castle down 5 cents, Eldorado 6, Bear 2 and Peterborough 5-8. Very few of the medium-price golds came through with net gains. In the oils Texas-Canadian gained 4, Acme 1 and Dalhousie 3.
