"POLITICAL TREACHERY" AIMED AT THE FARMERS

The manner in which Hon. Manning Doherty formerly Minister of Agriculture in the Drury Government, resigned his seat in the Legislature and broke away from the Progressives, because he saw that the only hope of the United Farmers attaining their objectives lay in an adherence to the Conservative cause, constitute an example to the farmers of the Dominion to be on their guard against the Liberal tactics of swallowing up the Progressives.

As the Farmers' Sun has pointed out, the swallowing process is already under way, and the Liberals are hoping that, by placing fusion candidates in the field, they will be able to stampede the farmer vote in their direction. The warning has gone out to the farmers of the Province through the medium of their official organ; and Hon. Manning Doherty has extended that warning to include the whole farming element of the Dominion.

He did that in the course of a recent speech at Ridgeway, in his old riding of East Kent, where he indicated the utter futility of the farmers supporting the "hydra-headed Progressive candidatures of the fusionists," and where he defined the Liberal attempt to swallow the Progressives body and soul as "the most despicable political treachery of the last quarter-century."

The voice of Hon. E. C. Dury's Minister of Agriculture was heard in Kent County where a fusionist onslaught is being made upon A. D. Chaplin, the Conservative, and in the course of his remarks, Hon. Manning Doherty expressed the hope that his voice might be heard by the farmers from end to end of the Dominion.

There were, as Hon. Manning Doherty expressed it, three outstanding reasons why the farmers' only hope lies in the support of Conservative candidates:

- 1. The United Farmer organizations have sought for honesty in Government.
2. One of the planks in the platformists.

form of the United Farmers has been temperance; and the revelations of the Customs Probe have demonstrated that the farmers have no hope in that regard from the King following.

3. Right Hon. Arthur Meighen has declared himself in favor of a national system of marketing for the products of the farms.

Hon. Manning Doherty informed his supporters in East Kent at the time of his resignation, the greatest and most important plank in the platform of any United Farmer organization is that national system of marketing.

He added, at the same time that Hon. Mr. Meighen had been absolutely sincere in his addition of that plank to his platform, for the reason that he has talked it through the West, and because of that, he has met with a remarkably fine reception wherever he has gone.

Hon. Manning Doherty added that the Liberal Government have never been sympathetic towards the farmers' cause, and that certain Progressives who have permitted themselves to be swallowed by the Liberals are traitors to the real cause of the farmers of the Dominion. The only farmer hope of attaining a practical operation for that one great plank in their platform is to support the followers of Hon. Mr. Meighen, and to vote Conservative wherever the opportunity arises.

That was the message of Hon. Manning Doherty at Ridgeway. It is to be hoped that the former Minister of Agriculture in the Drury Government will see fit to repeat the message at other points before the election campaign is over, and that still more United Farmers will have driven home to them the folly of supporting the
