A book by the heroine of Rachel Field's "All This, and Heaven Too" was recently brought into the office of the Macmillan Publishing Co. Entitled "Home Sketches in France, and Other Papers by the late Mrs. Henry M. Field" the book was published by Putnam in 1916.

This month the art of photography celebrates its one hundredth birthday. A Frenchman named Joseph-Nicéphore Niepce was the first to produce a photograph.

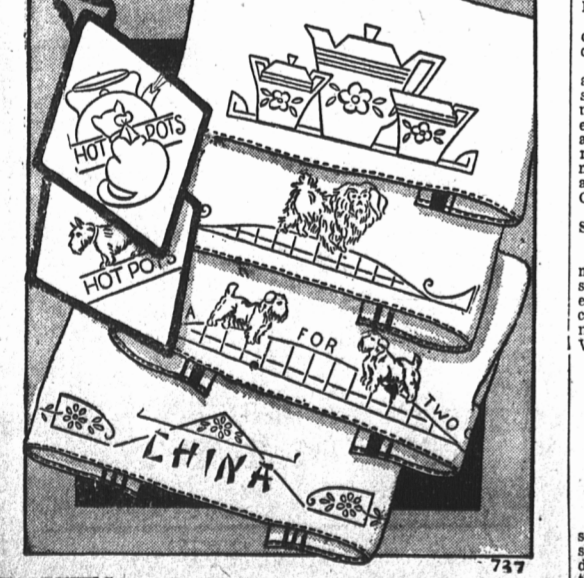
The breast muscles of a bird are about 100 times more powerful relatively, than those in a man. In Gibraltar, a local statute bans maternity to all women not of the British nationality.

THE COOK'S CORNER

PECAN BALLS:

Mix and sift two cups sifted flour with 1-4 cup sugar, 1-2 teaspoon salt, then chop in 1-2 cup butter. Add 2 teaspoons vanilla, 1 egg, 1 cup chopped pecan. Roll mixture into small balls, and place on greased baking sheets. Bake in oven at 325-degrees until browned.

Raisin and Peanut Butter Spread:

Two cups seedless raisins, half cup peanut butter, boiling water dash of salt. Put raisins through food grinder; add peanut butter to ground raisins; add enough boiling water to make to moist spreading consistency. Add dash of salt and mix all thoroughly. Keeps for days in refrigerator. If it hardens at all, merely add a little boiling water and mix to spreading consistency. Good with brown bread.

Soft Cream Cheese With Chopped Nuts

One-third package soft plenteo cream cheese; cream to spreading consistency, adding enough cream to thin. Add finely chopped blanched peanuts or walnuts. Makes two large sandwiches. Very good.

CHEESE CASSEROLE

(Milk used—3 cups) 12 slices day-old bread 2 cups grated Canadian cheese 3 eggs, slightly beaten 3 cups milk 1-2 teaspoon salt 1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce Paprika. Spread the slices of bread with softened butter. Place a layer of 6 slices in a large shallow baking dish and sprinkle generously with the grated cheese. Repeat the process, making 2 layers. Combine the remaining ingredients and pour over the bread. Sprinkle lightly with paprika. Place in a dish of hot water and bake in a slow oven 1-4 hours. Serve hot, 6 generous servings.
