**STRATHCONA AGAIN**  
\$100,000 FOR MCGILL.

MONTREAL, June 6th—A feature of the annual Convocation of the Faculty of Medicine, McGill University, was the announcement made by Principal Peterson that Lord Strathcona had donated another \$100,000 for the completion of the equipment in the new Million Dollar Medical Building the creation of which his earlier munificent gifts has made possible.

It was announced that Dr. James Douglas has donated \$25,000 for the co-ordination of research work in pathological laboratories.
