KANG IS GRATEFUL.

Chinese Reformer Talks Well of Canada.

Kang Yu Wei, the Chinese refugee, formerly a member of the Chinese Yamen and confidential adviser of the Emperor, before setting sail from Vancouver for the Orient—presumably for Japan, as his life would be forfeit by setting his foot on Chinese territory—has addressed a letter to Mr. Parmelee, controller of Chinese immigration, in which he thanks him for the kindness shown his fellow countrymen, a kindness which he thinks they fully deserve.

"My fellow countrymen," he writes, "need every sympathy from the hands of your good government. I hope the day is not far distant when our own Empire will arise from her long slumbers and declare to the civilized world that she has adopted every progressive measure, following the example of all modern nations by opening her doors to trade and commerce, for the betterment of her subjects."

"During my stay in Canada I have received hundreds of encouraging letters from all parts of the world seeking information concerning the welfare of the Empire and of the best methods to be adopted for the uplifting of our country, all of which goes to show how earnest my countrymen are."

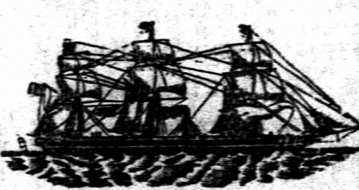
