P.E. Island Brief Presented At Ottawa

Financial arrangements between the Dominion and the Province of Prince Edward Island, presented at Dominion-Provincial Conference, April 29, by Premier J. Walter Jones.

CONFERENCE OF REPRESENTATIVES of the governments of the provinces, including the premiers thereof, was held at Ottawa on the 27th June, 1936.

PROVINCE HAS NO MOTHERS' ALLOWANCES, cost-of-living bonus, or technical training for the general public as an integral part of the school system.

From the time of Confederation this Province has requested the Dominion Government to make arrangements for the subsidy.

FRUGALITY IN EXPENDITURE - Prince Edward Island having almost reached the limit of revenue available from taxation.

IN KEEPING WITH THE trend and limit of government revenues, provincial and municipal governments have performed a great frugality and economy.

EXPENDITURES ON AGRICULTURE and development are low, in part owing to the lack of any public domain, but this may be enforced.
