LONDON, Dec. 18 (Special)—In the height of a gale a huge cantilever crane at Messrs. Vickers's naval construction yard at Barrow was blown over, with the result that two men, Thomas Scott and Thomas McKenzie, of Birkenhead, were killed, and 12 other workmen injured.
