LONDON, March 2.—Upon the conclusion of diplomatic exchanges between the United States and Great Britain with respect to the Newfoundland fisheries case, which are proceeding slowly, it is believed that negotiations will be opened looking to a more satisfactory settlement of the Pacific sealing question.
