HISTORIC MONUMENTS Detailed List of Stones and Inscriptions in Old Protestant Cemetery, Elm Avenue, Charlottetown.

Note of Explanation: In order to facilitate the finding of stones or monuments, they have been listed in "rows", and each has been given a number. The "rows" are by no means always straight and there are many gaps between stones...

- Row Stone No. Names, Dates, Inscriptions, etc. Condition of Stone & Type
37 1 (at two birch trees) Lizzie A. wife of W. B. MORRISON, d. Mar. 2, 1872, age 26. Also their dau. Emily Maud, d. Aug. 10, 1870, age 8 mos. - Gothic slab, clumsily cemented 1-2's, and bottom of stone is broken off.
37 2 (at walk) Sarah, wife of Allan CAMERON, d. Mar. 1, 1817, age 26. - Slab, badly weathered.
37 3 John BRUCE, MOPHEE, d. July 6, 1869 - Slab, badly mended 1-2's.
37 4 No inscription.
37 5 Mary wife of Donald MCKINLEY, of York River, d. June 9, 1851, age 59 - Fine slab.
37 6 (starts close to walk) Hester Ball, wife of L. G. WORTHY, d. Aug. 1, 1863 (or 1868), age 67. Lawrence G. (or C.) WORTHY, d. Oct. 20, 1862. (Born 1784?) - Square slab.
37 7 Norton Aglion SLANEY, Esq., a native of England, d. Mar. 1, 1817 (or 1817?), aged 4 yrs. - Badly broken flat stone, 3 halves out of alignment. Should be straightened and levelled.
37 8 Ellen Kelly, wife of Thos. MUGFORD, d. July 17, 1870, age 27 (?) - Slab - 1.
37 9 Patience Eliza, dau. of - - - - - Upper part of slab. Family name and dates gone.
37 10 Elizabeth, wife of Paul TOWAN (?), d. Nov. 17, 1865, age 35. - Slab - 1.
37 11 Jane Webster, wife of Wm. SNEEDESTON, d. Jan. 8, 1861 (or 1861), age 44 (?) - Slab - 1.
37 12 Wm. SNEEDESTON, d. Nov. 23, 1866, age 61. - Slab - 1.
37 13 Laughlan McDONALD, d. June 10 (7), 1870, age 75. Mary, d. Dec. 6, 1873, aged 47. - Slab, sunken too far.
37 14 Samuel McDONALD, d. Mar. 29, 1854, age 29. Even, d. age 38. (date hidden in ground). - Slab sunken too far.
37 15 (near birch tree) Maria J. COX, wife of G. F. GARDINER, d. June 23 (?), 1869. Age 26. John B. COX, d. June 17, 1866, age 56. - Sq. shaft, leaning slightly and ornamental top loose.
37 16 Donald MCKINNON, late of York River, and a native of the Island of Mont. Argyleshire, d. June 4, 1836, aged 79. - Fine slab - 1/2, except that bottom is broken off and untidily stuck in ground.
37 17 Chas. McDONALD, d. Sept. 30, 1846, age 21. - Fine slab - 1/2.
37 18 (at walk) Mrs. - - - - - wife of - - - - - (rest of inscription weathered away). - Badly broken slab, 2 halves, one cemented very badly, now apart again.
37 19 Mary PIPPY, relict of the late Joseph PIPPY, d. Mar. 7, 1839, age 79. - Fine slab - 1/2.
37 20 Joseph PIPPY, d. April 10, 1837, age 73. - Slab - 1/2.
37 21 Mrs. STAMPER, d. July 24, 1859, age 70. - Slab - 1/2.
37 22 (at walk) Lydia Purdy, age 9 yrs. - Sarah, age 4 yrs. Children of Elijah and Ann PURDY "sleepers here." - Slab - clamped hands design - 1/2.
37 23 (first stone at walk) Angus McDONALD, d. Feb. 9, 1858, age 38. Also his wife Isabella B. B., d. Oct. 1, 1854, age 73. - Slab, sunken too far.
37 24 Donald McDONALD, of York River, d. Aug. 16, 1865, age 87. - Slab - 1/2.
37 25 Isabella, wife of David A. BEAR, d. April 10, 1866, age 36. - Slab - 1/2. Weeping willow design.
37 26 Wm. SMALLE, d. Feb. 1, 1858, age 42. Also his wife Ann, d. Nov. 12, 1848, age 31. - Slab - 1/2.
37 27 (gap) Elizabeth, wife of John (7) MCKINNON, d. June 28, 1868, age 68. - Broken slab, badly mended 1-2's.
37 28 Ellen, dau. of Duncan & Rosa CAMERON, B. Aug. 14, 1849, d. Sept. 10, 1859, and Hugh, their son, b. May 8, 1847, d. Sept. 14, 1850. - Slab, seems putting on a base because bottom broken off.
37 29 Jas. STEWART, d. May 6, 1871, age 46. - Slab, unusual design - 1/2.
37 30 (rest of inscription removed).
37 31 (gap) John - - - - - (5 letter name) - (rest of inscription weathered away). - Slab - face badly weathered.
37 32 - - - - - d. Jan. 11, 1870, age 66. (Name from newspaper). - Lower 1-2 of slab, top gone.
37 33 Hammond, son of John and Dinah SMITH, d. Sept. 7, 1851, age 7. - Small slab, 1/2.
37 34 Malcolm MCKINNON, d. June 25, 1854, age 62. - Slab - 1/2.
37 35 Hugh MCKINNON, d. Dec. 27, 1827, age 73. Also Roderick, his son, d. Aug. 12, 1836. (Another name with date, may be hidden in ground). - Upper part of slab Shown in ground.
37 36 (In advance of others in row - name) Mr. Ovide RICHARDSON, formerly of Selby, York Co., England, for many years General Agent for the Colonial Church Society in British North America, d. March 22, 1851, age 63.
37 37 (at walk) Sarah, wife of Allan CAMERON, d. Mar. 10, 1835, age 51. - Slab - 1/2. This stone and the two following it are in one plot, surrounded by an iron fence, which perhaps could be repaired.
37 38 Allan CAMERON, d. Jan. 18, 1841, age 76 (?), also his children, Charles, d. Mar. 5, 1841, age 25; John, d. March 11, 1842 (?), age 23; Ann, d. May 1, 1843, age 20. (rest of inscription hidden in ground). Also Catherine, d. Oct. 20, 18 - - - - - age 18. - Slab, crudely cemented 1-2's.
37 39 Christina, wife of James B. - - - - - and dau. of Allan CAMERON, d. May 13 (?), 1853 (?). - Slab, badly weathered.
37 40 Flora and Margaret, aged 19, and Sarah, 15 yrs., daughters of Alexander and Nancy McLEAN, who were very suddenly removed from this world by fire on Feb. 25, 1845. "Weep not dear friends for those you love. O woe not over their tomb. The flesh though in corruption sown, Immortal yet will bloom." Also, Neil, age 8 mos. - Fine slab - 1/2.
37 41 Allan MCKINNON, native of Mill, Argyleshire, d. Mar. 8, 1823 (or 1823). - Slab, face beginning to weather.
37 42 John MCKINNON, d. Jan. 18, 1841, age 19. - Slab - 1/2.
37 43 Hannah McCLAIN, d. May 11, 1851, age 4 yrs. - Small slab - 1/2.
37 44 (long gap) Louisa Caroline JENKINS, d. Sept. 13, 1868, age 37. - Broken slab, in 3 pieces.
37 45 Penelope JENKINS, dau. of the Recto of this Parish d. of consumption Mar. 24, 1845, age 19. Also of Mar. Elizabeth, her sister, d. Jan. 21, 1832, age 4 mos. - Fine slab - 1/2.
37 46 Penelope - (probably a JENKINS) - Gothic stone, 1/2 (resting almost gone).
37 47 Jane - - - - - (?), d. Mar. 2, 1863 - age 46. Also their infant son John, d. Aug. 2, 1863 (1868), age 6 mos. - Slab, very crudely cemented 1-2's.
37 48 Flora Margaret, infanti dau. of Roderick and Ellen McLAIN, d. Oct. 2, 1863, age 3 yrs. 9 mos. - Tiny slab - 1/2. (long gap) Joseph HILL, d. Nov. 25, 1843, age 48. - Fine slab - 1/2.
37 49 Thomas - - - - - son of Wm. and Hannah JAKEMAN, d. Sept. 23, 1839, age 5. - Small slab - 1/2.
37 50 John E. JAKEMAN, d. Sept. 18, 1838. - Slab - 1/2, but sunken. Perhaps another name hidden.
37 51 No inscription.
37 52 (at walk) - - - - - d. April 8, 1860, age 61 yrs., leaving a wife and children. - 1-2 slab, 1/2.
37 53 (at birch tree, near fence) John MacLAREN, d. May 11, 1848, age 73, and his wife Catherine, d. Dec. 7, 1851, age 49. Also his son John, d. August 16, 1834, age 8. - Gothic stone - 1/2.
