For Great Britain, Tuesday, 10 p.m. Letters are collected from street letter boxes of 6 a.m., 2 p.m. and 8 p.m.

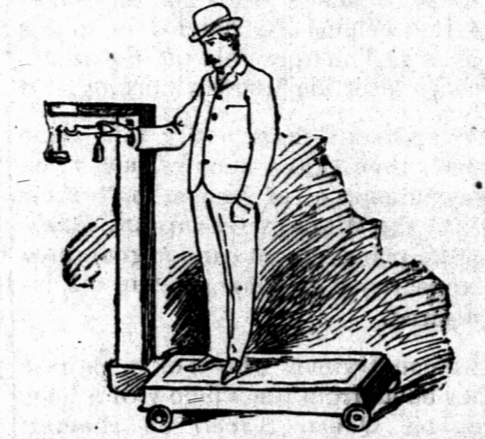

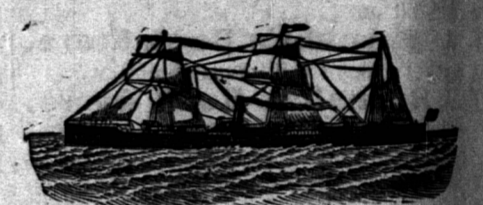
