P. E. I. BARQUE ABANDONED.

London, Jan. 20.—The British barque Rita, Captain Olsen, from Cardiff December 23 for Para, was abandoned in a sinking condition. Her crew were rescued and have landed at St. Vincent, C. V. The Rita was built in 1888 at Prince Edward Island and registered 378 tons net. She sailed from Charlottetown, P. E. I. and was owned by Wm. Richards.

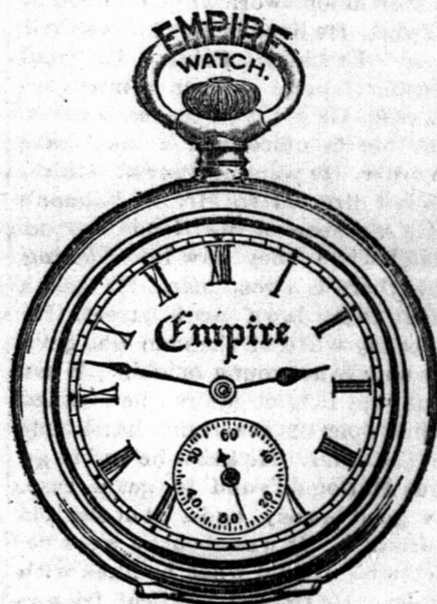
