Stock Markets At A Glance

CHICAGO, June 13 — (AP) — Grain futures with the exception of oats were steady to firm in today's trading.

WINNIPEG, June 12 — (CP) — Export business in Canadian wheat with the United Kingdom was estimated by traders at 6,000,000 bushels today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange.
 In other dealings United States buyers took 500,000 bushels of oats.

TORONTO, June 13 — (CP) — Moderate weakness was registered by Toronto Stock Market in the afternoon period today following a strong opening. An index gain of 20 was held by the Western Oils. The Base Metal Stocks slipped back to show a net index loss of 38 and the Golds lost 32.

NEW YORK, June 13 — (AP) — Buying of assorted aircrafts, rails and utilities put props under today's Stock Market although many leaders continued to stumble. Prices improved after the opening and gains of fractions to 3 points or so were well distributed at the close.
 The Associated Press 60-stock average was up 2 of a point at 65.9.

MONTREAL, June 12 — (CP) — All key groups reached new peaks in the indices in trading today on the Stock Exchange and Curb Market. Market students reported that result of the Dominion election gave a further lift to investment sentiment which has been bullish recently. Industrials were at their best in the averages for eight years, utilities and golds for five and banks since the index for the group was established in September. Individual gains were mostly fractional but were steeper in places.
