FAMOUS RESTAURATEUR LEAVES BULK OF MONEY TO CHARITY

NEW YORK, June 22.—Louis Sherry, famous restaurateur who died June 8th, left the bulk of an estate valued at more than \$1,000,000 to the Presbyterian Hospital as residuary legatee.

The money will be known as the Bertha Sherry memorial fund, in honor of his widow, and will be devoted, under terms of the will, to the care of cancer patients.

Mrs. Sherry receives \$50,000 outright and a \$6,000 annuity. She had been separated from her husband since 1908. A son receives \$50,000 and there are lesser bequests to friends.
