INSPECTOR OF FOXES.—Dr. A. A. Black, of Summerside, has been appointed by the Minister of Agriculture to be Inspector of Foxes for Prince County, in the place of Dr. J. A. Croken, who has removed to Charlottetown.

ANOTHER CAR.—Mr. D. C. McKay, formerly of the Nova Scotia Motor Car Company, is expected to arrive in the city in a few days. Mr. McKay is having a King motor car shipped to this city, where it has been sold.

ROYAL SALUTE.—A royal salute of 21 guns was fired in Charlottetown yesterday, by No. 4 Battery, commanded by Capt. D. A. McKinnon, in commemoration of the ascension of King George V. to the throne.

VALUE OF EGG CIRCLES.—Mr. J. C. Stuart, Superintendent of Co-operative Egg Circles for the Dominion Government reports that there are now one hundred of these circles controlled by his department besides a number of private circles. Of these one hundred, it is interesting to note, no fewer than sixty are located in Prince Edward Island; forty are distributed over the provinces of Ontario and Quebec. That the egg circle is proving a profitable investment is shown by the net returns received by members. For the six months ended December 31, 1913, profits from eggs handled by the egg circles average 22 1/2 per cent. over local store prices. The "Canadian Farm" of May 1 contains the following in regard to egg circles: "There is certainly room for the egg circle in Canada. There are millions of dollars wasted every year by bad handling of eggs. If every egg in Canada were marketed through the egg circle or by similar methods this waste would be saved. There would also be more eggs produced. In 1913 Canada imported 13,250,000 dozen eggs and during 1914 to date 6,000,000 dozen Canadian eggs have been brought into Canada. There is room for considerable expansion in egg production in this country, before the home market is supplied. These facts are particularly interesting to poultry of this province in view of the large number of egg circles which the Island boasts. The other Maritime Provinces are becoming interested in the "circle" business also. It is a proud fact to record that we have to look to Prince Edward Island to find an organizer. Mr. T. A. Benson, Poultry Expert of Nova Scotia, has gone over to Nova Scotia, where he will stay a week or so organizing egg circles at different points. He will probably visit Pictou, Shubenacadie, River John and other points. He has seven appointments to meet. Mr. Benson's knowledge of the poultry business and every minute detail in connection therewith is well known to need and highly interesting lectures which he has delivered from time to time in the province, notably at the meeting of the Farmers' Institute some weeks ago—being ample testimony of his ability to handle eggs. There is not the slightest doubt that those "circles" for the organization of which Mr. Benson will be responsible will prove as profitable as any in Canada.
