RECIPROCITY ENDORSED AT WASHINGTON.

A brief despatch in yesterday morning's Guardian brought the important news that the reciprocity agreement had been endorsed by the American Senate by an almost two-thirds vote.

The question is now one for the Canadian Parliament and people to settle for themselves, and there can be no question as to the views of a large majority of the members of both the Ottawa House of Commons and the Senate.

And we can hardly doubt that in this case the majority in the two Houses of Parliament represents a somewhat proportionate majority of the people of Canada in favor of the agreement.

want reciprocity they can and will have it. If on the other hand the majority do not want it, the agreement will die in its cradle.

A great privilege is thus given to the people of Canada in thus having it in their own free choice to say whether they want what both parties were agreed but a few years ago would be a great boon to the Dominion.

Possibly some may assume, because the American Congress and people appear desirous for reciprocity, that they think they have the best of the bargain. That by no means follows.

CLOSURE, OR A TIME LIMIT FOR SPEECHES.

It seems not improbable that the next Parliament of Canada will see some plan of closure adopted. The reason why the Government will not introduce a measure of that sort in the present Parliament is because it would be resisted indefinitely, and what with supplies not yet voted and with the reciprocity agreement and a redistribution bill to pass there will be no time for other contentious legislation.

in Canada against any system of closure, although it has been adopted in England, the land par excellence of free speech, and appears to have effected good there. There is less objection in this country, to a time limit, which has come much in vogue at political campaign meetings. It would seem preferable to closure for adoption by the Canadian Parliament, and would effect much saving of time and in the bulk and expense of Hansard.

A time limit would also have a beneficial effect upon the speakers themselves by enforcing the habit of condensation. A condensed speech would be much more likely to be read by a member's constituents than the padded verbiage which occupies two to four hours in delivery.

CANADA AND ARGENTINA.

There is one country in South America which is running a pretty close race even with prosperous Canada these days and that is Argentina. It is a large country, and still but about one third of the area of Canada.

had increased to 4,749,149 and is now 6,806,000. In twenty years Argentina has thus gained three millions in population.

In trade there is also a pretty close rivalry between the northern Dominion and the southern Republic. Canada's imports last year were \$369,315,427 and the exports \$279,247,551. Argentina's imports were \$292,159,540 and her exports \$383,443,715. The total trade of Argentina was greater by 25 millions than that of Canada, with this difference that Canada's imports exceeded the imports by 90 millions, while in Argentina the exports were 90 millions in excess of the imports—which is no bad thing in its way.
