SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON
GREATNESS THROUGH SERVICE
LESSON. Mark x. 32-45.
JULY 12.

GOLDEN TEXT. Mark x. 45
"For verily the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give His life a ransom for many."

THE NARRATIVE

The first paragraph of our lesson today describes the circumstances under which the special touching concerning greatness through service was given. It is full of solemnity, and should be most carefully considered. It presents us a picture of the Lord with His disciples, travelling towards Jerusalem. He, however, is seen before them, that is going ahead of them, and alone. They, at a distance, were still following. Let us in amazement and in fear. It is a graphic portrayal of the mental mood of these solemn days. The face of Jesus was steadfastly set toward the final things in His earthly mission. These men, loving Him, were desirous of being loyal to Him; and yet were strangely perplexed by the things He was doing and saying. They were amazed.

Again He seems to have halted, and called the twelve to Him, and they deliberately He told them again, in most clear language, what the program ahead must be. He spoke of His condemnation, His deliverance to the Gentiles, His persecution, His death, ending all with the clear declaration of His resurrection.

It was at this time that James and John preferred their request. Matthew tells us that they did so through their mother.

In considering this it is important to notice first of all the inspiration of that request, for to do so is to save us from much misapprehension. He, as we have seen, had spoken with absolute clearness as to the pathway of suffering and death that He was about to tread. They immediately asked that they might occupy certain positions in His glory. This in

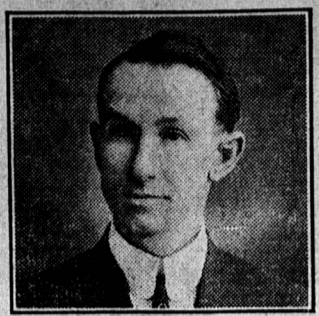

Itself is a revelation of their faith in Him, and of their conviction that He must come into the place of authority. It may be that they were ignoring what He said about suffering. It may be that they were affirming their confidence that even if this were so, He must somehow be triumphant. The central fact, however, cannot be lost sight of, that they believed that He must come to the hour of His glory.

What they sought was association with Him in that hour in power and authority. It is possible that there was a mixture in their request of selfishness, but it is necessary to point out that if so, our Lord ignored it, for nothing He said to those two men rebuked such an attitude. There can be no doubt that they had no true apprehension of all that was involved of the pathway of suffering, and this the Lord clearly declared as He said, "Ye know not what ye ask. Are ye able

to drink the cup that I drink? asked but they were prepared to give themselves up — or to be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with?" This does not alter the fact of the heroism of their answer as they said, "We are able." It was language revealing the very attitude of mind that made it possible for Christ to receive men into fellowship with Himself in service. They did not know what they were prepared to give themselves up to anything, in order to this association with Himself in authority and power. There was not a touch of rebuke in His reply. He declared that they should do that which they were able to do. He knew perfectly well that they were unable in their own strength, but He also knew that where there was such abandonment to Himself He was able to enable them to do and to bear the otherwise impossible things. The only correction was that of their request for certain particular places. These He declared it was not His to give except to those for whom it was prepared. Thus the particular position that they would occupy was left an open question.

It is evident that the ten understood the request as being one for personal aggrandisement, and they were moved with indignation concerning James and John. All that followed was an answer to the indignation of the ten, and not to the request of the two. The two were included in the general teaching. In this reply the Lord first of all described the gentle method in a declaration of singular accuracy.

Even until this time it applies to the methods of the world as to greatness. The people are under the rule of those who lord it over them. These in their turn are under the authority of others; so that the gradations of greatness move upward, according to positions of authority. The method of the Kingdom of God is entirely different. Therein the gradations of greatness move downward, until the lowest, and the one who serves most perfectly, is found to be the greatest.

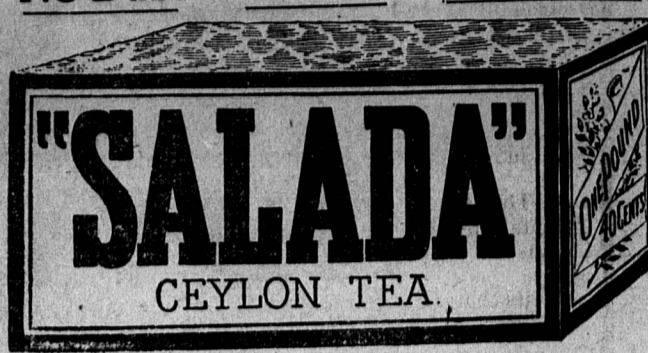
