Contract Bridge

Subterfuge

There are many situations in which the defenders' only weapon in subterfuge. It may not be a strong weapon—the declarer may easily turn it aside—but it is undeniable that some weapon is better than none at all! Consider this case:

South dealer.
Both sides vulnerable.

♠ A J 9 7 2
♥ 6 4 3
♦ 5 3
♣ K J 5

♠ Q 10 8
♥ J 10 9 7
♦ K 9 6
♣ 5 4

♠ K 5 4
♥ K 2
♦ Q 10 8
♣ 7 6 3 2

♠ 6 3
♥ A Q 8
♦ A J 4 2
♣ A Q 10 9

The bidding:
South West North East
1 ♠ Pass 1 ♠ Pass
2 NT Pass 3 NT Pass
Pass Pass

West opened the heart Jack. East put up the king, and South won.

Declarer counted his sure tricks, and saw that he would need two spades in addition to his four clubs, two hearts and one diamond. So he immediately led a spade toward dummy.

West, meanwhile, had been doing some analyzing of his own. He could not, of course, make such an accurate count of declarer's winners, but when the spade suit could and did draw a general deduction.

It was obvious that South did not have the spade king—he would have cashed it before leading low toward dummy. He probably had two, possibly three, small spades. With this holding, opposite the precise spade suit in dummy, a declarer's correct technique is to play dummy's nine (if West plays low), in hope of driving out the king or queen. Then, later, a second spade is led to the jack for the finesse against the remaining high honor.

West could see very plainly that this line of play would work against his side; so, to confuse the issue as much as possible he went right in with the spade queen on the first lead of the suit. The ace won, and South returned to his hand
