MRS. COADY'S RELEASE.

If the release of Mrs. Coady from jail were necessary in the interests of mercy or of justice there were two ways in which that object could have been legally effected. The one most obviously proper was the payment of the fine. If too poor to pay it herself the sympathetic neighbors, to say nothing of sympathetic and wealthy officials could have done this.

The facts as stated and the law as quoted in this journal are not disputed by the Patriot, which speaks for the Premier. The question remains to be considered by the people and by the higher authority whose prerogative has been usurped, why was the illegal course taken when there were at hand legitimate means of effecting the same end? Can it be possible that the Attorney General advised or consented to so gross a violation of law and so grave a usurpation of power? A shocked community feels that the gate has been opened for other and still graver abuses in the future. Whither are we drifting?
