ANARCHIST MURDERS.

Since the days of Cain the lust of murder has been in the world. Private or public grudge, or of imaginary ambition, jealousy, rivalry, or the desire for gain have been the fruitful source of murder. But the murder of rulers had been till the 19th century a merely spasmodic and occasional thing. Some sixty years ago arose the anarchist body throughout Europe and its related organization, Nihilism in Russia. Proudhon in France, was the apostle of anarchy. He taught that the ideal state of society was without rulers or governments, and that every man should be a law unto himself.

His followers and Anarchist organization generally have extended this principle to include the removal of all rulers by assassination, and during a generation past they have made attempts upon the lives of almost every crowned head in Europe. Emperors, Kings and high officers of state have in various countries been made the victims of this infernal organization. Many of the people of continental Europe have indeed suffered great oppression at the hands of their rulers in the past, but the Anarchist makes no distinctions. The most worthy, the most benign of sovereigns, is little more secure against the bomb or the dagger of the Anarchist than the most cruel tyrant.

Hence we have the atrocious attempt to assassinate the young King and Queen of Spain on the day of their marriage. King Alfonso has been during his brief reign a good ruler. He has earnestly sought to acquaint himself with the duties of his exalted position and to qualify himself to promote the happiness and welfare of his people. He was personally popular with the Spanish people, and the demonstrations on the occasion of the royal marriage would indicate that the youthful King and Queen held a warm place in the hearts of their subjects. It is a sad revelation of human depravity that it should have developed

In these later years an organization, which has spread through almost all civilized lands, based on a creed of wholesale murder. Its members are the enemies not only of kings, rulers and governments, of law and the existing social order, but of the human race as well. They would reduce human society to chaos, if they could. The world is organized against them, and has been long so organized, but the Anarchist organization persists and while it remains every crowned head, or head of a state is in danger of being struck down. In many respects the world grows better and kinder, the pessimist may still point out that never in the distant past was there throughout the world so widespread and so devilish an organization as that of Anarchism.

TWENTY-SIX YEARS AGO.

The Canada Temperance Act 1878 was adopted in Queen's County in the summer of 1880, by a vote of 1317 for, and 99 against, the majority being 1218. There was a central committee for Queen's County, of which Hon. A. A. McDonald was chairman and the late Rev. George W. Hodgson, was general secretary. Some other members of the committee were the late Father McGillivray, George W. Millner, John Jury, Rev Isaac Murray, Hon. H. J. Callbeck, F. W. Hales, H. J. Candall, M. P. Hogan, and others. The signatures for the petition calling for the Act were largely obtained on polling day at a general election, when almost every person signed who was asked. There was no organized opposition at the election which brought the Act into force, and no attempt has since been made to repeal it until the present movement by the temperance people to that end. In the campaign to carry the Act in Queen's, clergy of all creeds heartily co-operated, and it is confidently hoped that the same influential elements will now cordially assist to repeal the Scott Act and adopt the better measure of prohibition.

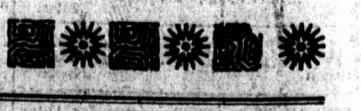
