### NEW PRIVILEGES FOR ALL.

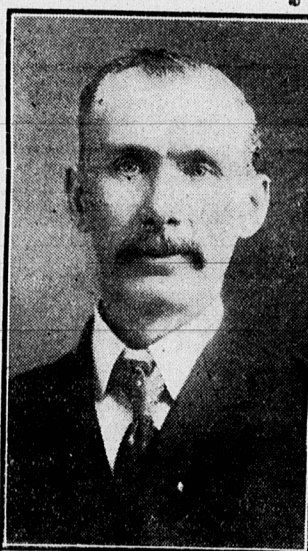

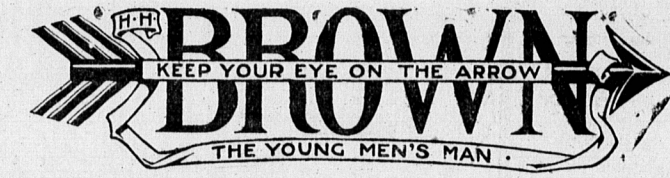

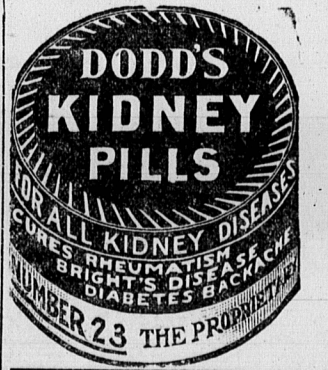
