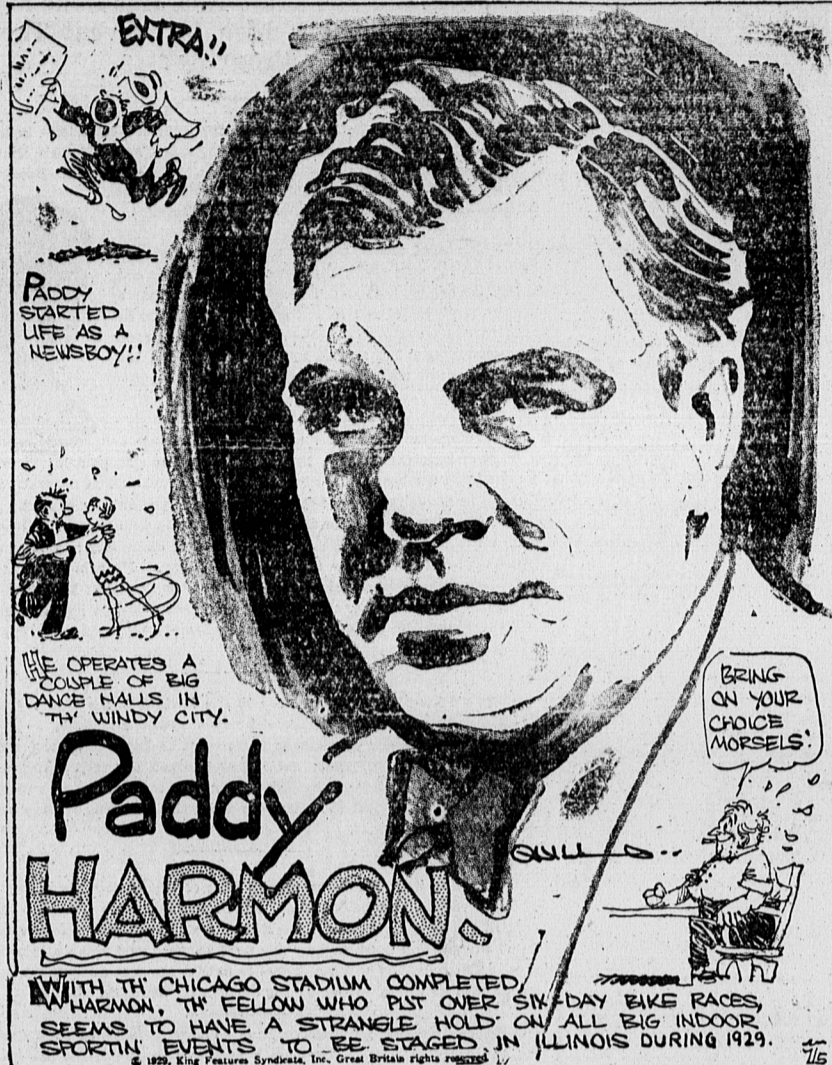
After the distribution of prizes to the various winners in the athletic events, three rousing cheers were given Mr. and Mrs. Burnett and others.

Chicago's Master of Sports

If you're planning on staging a big indoor sporting event at Chicago, you will likely come in contact with Paddy Harmon. He is a hard fellow to see but, if you have patience, you'll be ushered eventually into an office in a tall skyscraper that contains nothing much but a heavily littered desk and Paddy Harmon. Nate Lewis, his matchmaker, may be cluttering up a corner with Eddie Kane or some fight manager but that, we presume, is to be expected.

Paddy is now the Big Boy with the Chicago Stadium—that steel, concrete and brick structure on the west side which houses everything from circus to championship bowls. The Coliseum, Chicago's older sports rendezvous, is still in business and, with Jack Dempsey signed to promote

bouts there this winter, may offer some competition, but Harmon has seating capacity at the Stadium and that's a hard thing to talk down when crowds mean money.

Harmon is apt to be to Chicago what Tex Rickard was to New York. He does more hand-shaking than President Hoover and he can't allot certain days to it. If he can hold up under the strain, he'll be more prominent this Fall than he was last Spring and even last Spring he wasn't a guy to be laughed at. You've just got to be like this fellow with the big sparkler shining on his finger.

Paddy started out as a newsboy and made good selling papers before Chicago had gang wars. Now the racket is easier. He branched out into six-day bike races and popularized 'em. He started a dance hall and "took Chicago's dancing daugh-

ters out of the cabarets," as one Chicagoan expresses it. Now he has two dancing palaces and dabbles a little in other side lines.

Right now, Harmon is all aglow over the Chicago Stadium. Next winter, he hopes to have the Chicago Black Hawks playing their Chicago games in his new sport palace. And fights? There'll be plenty of ring clashes staged in the Windy City next Fall and winter.

"We have the site," is the way Harmon puts it. "It's easy to talk about building a stadium, but it is another matter to build one. This one is finished. And we're going to have plenty of attractions to keep it open all the time."

Yes, it would seem that Dempsey is in another tough promotion spot—trying to buck Paddy Harmon and that Chi Stadium.
