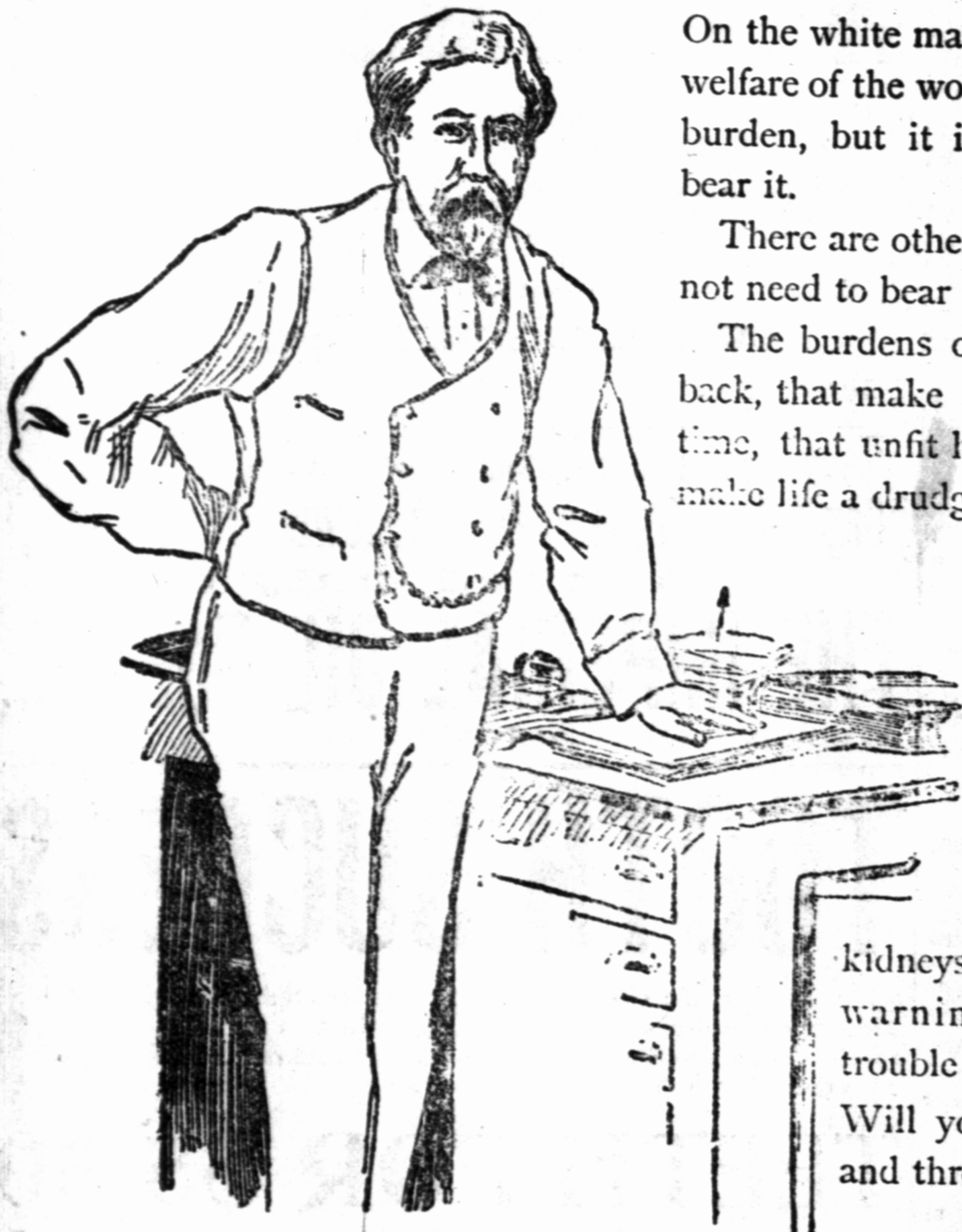


THE WHITE MAN'S BURDEN.

TO REVOLUTIONIZE WAR.

Wonderful Invention Announced by a Torontoian.

TORONTO, Jan. 24.—Mr. A. Macdonald, a coal merchant of the city, who has heretofore displayed no particular eccentricities, says he is one of a syndicate of inventors who have invented machinery for throwing nitro-glycerine or other liquid high explosives in showers. They believe this will revolutionize warfare and state that machines could be got ready for shipment to South Africa in a week which will use dynamite or nitro-glycerine in the form of a shower. Each machine has a capacity per minute of a hundred and sixty pounds of high explosive. The shower can be thrown a thousand yards or more and the guns from which the discharge is made will be mounted on a species of traction engine which can make a speed of from eighteen to twenty miles an hour over quite rough country, carrying the men who will operate it. The explosion of nitro-glycerine so thrown would, it is stated, be immensely more effective than shell fire.

GOVERNMENT CONTROL.

TORONTO, Jan. 23.—At last night's meeting of the city council, Mayor McDonald gave notice that he would move that this council petition the Parliament of Canada, at its next session to pass an act authorizing the Postmaster-General to acquire all the existing telegraph and telephone systems, and make such extensions to and operate the same in connection with and as a part of the postal system of the Dominion, or, in the alternative, to construct a new system or systems of telegraph or telephones, and operate the same as aforesaid, and that the co-operation of the cities, towns and other municipalities of Canada be asked, to the end that an act may be passed for the purposes aforesaid.
