Military junta headed by Romulo Betancourt overthrows Venezuelan government, ousting President Medina. Argentine revolt quiets down after return to power of Juan Peron.

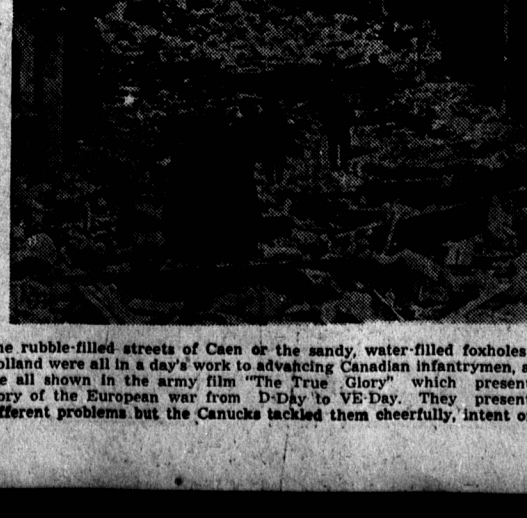

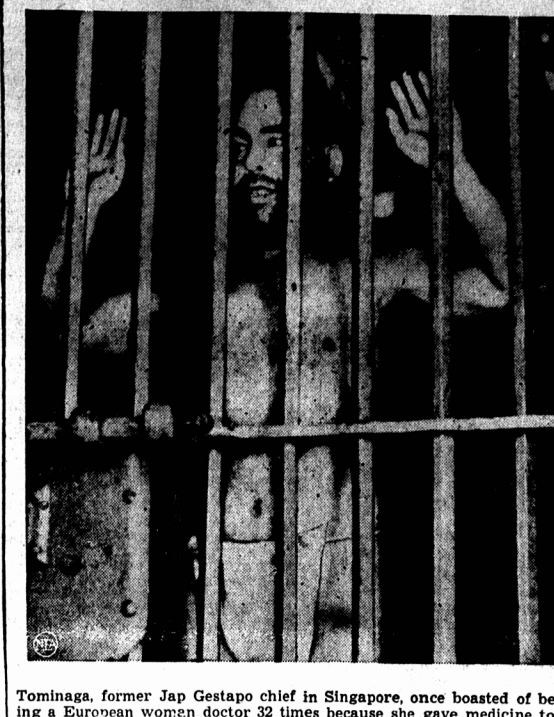
