# ABDUCTION OF YOUNG WOMEN BY MAFIA BAND

### A Sensational Case of Kidnapping Which is Stirring Up Certain Parts of Italy — The Bold Work Performed by the Abductors

ROME, Nov. 27.—Two pretty daughters of one of the principal industrial magnates of Palermo, while taking a walk in the company of their mother and smaller sisters along the Via dei Colli, the main promenade of the city one afternoon last week, were suddenly surrounded by a band of eight youths, who bore away the two girls by main force to carriages in waiting, which drove rapidly away.

The girls, whose ages are 19 and 17, respectively, are supposed to be the victims of a Mafia plot, owing to their father's refusal to pay blackmail.

The next day the police surrounded a house in which the girls were imprisoned, forced an entrance, and were successful in capturing four of the band.

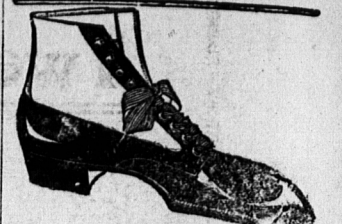
