Essay Discusses Rural Recreation

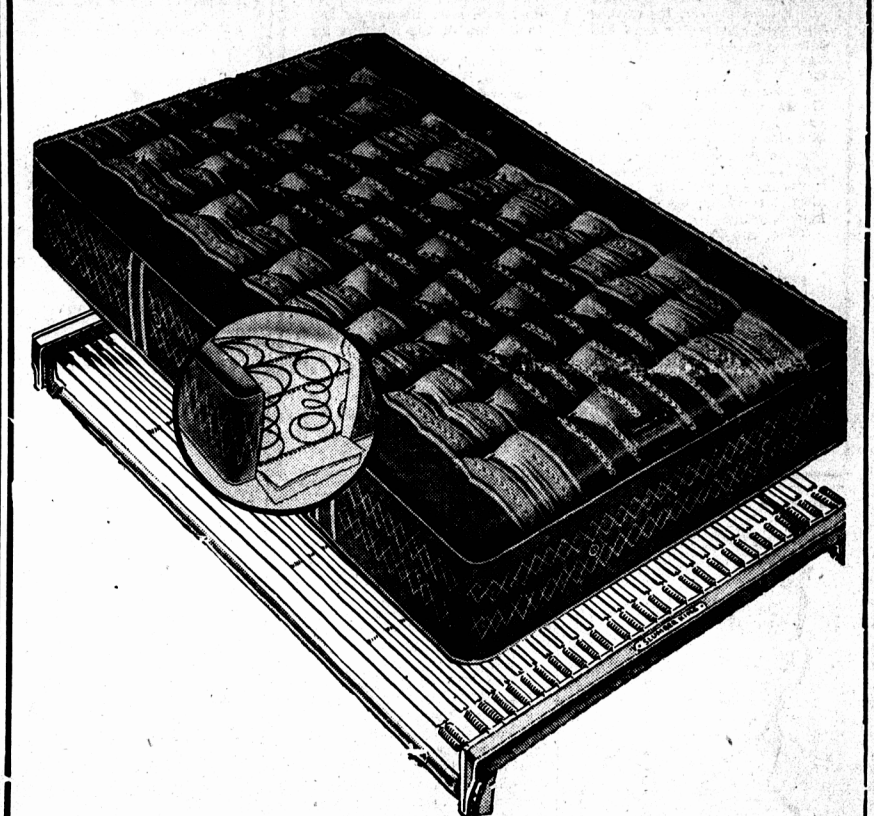
The following essay by Miss Joan Howlett, Gowan, Bras, was read by her at a recent district convention of Women's Institutes:
