A PLOT DISCLOSED.
ROME, March 27.—The mysterious arrest of a wealthy Jew, of the name of Gozzar, at the Grand Hotel, Naples, last Monday, is now generally attributed to the discovery of a plot against the life of the Czar, during his coming visit to Italy.
