SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON

FOURTH QUARTER.
WORDS AND WORKS OF JESUS AS RECORDED IN THE GOSPELS.
LESSON VIII.—NOVEMBER 25.
THE WORLD'S TEMPERANCE SUNDAY. Isa. 5. 11-23.

Memorize verse 11.
GOLDEN TEXT.
I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection.—1 Cor. 9. 27.

INTRODUCTION.
The prophet's seething re-velation of Israel contained in this chapter (v. 8-30) is introduced by the familiar parable of the vineyard, (v. 1-7). This introductory passage is considered one of the "finest exhibitions of rhetorical skill and power which the book contains." In the form of simple story the prophet has addressed an assemblage of his countrymen, reciting the experience he has had with his refractory vineyard. He demands of his hearers a verdict, and they readily assent to the condemnation of the vineyard without at first appreciating the fact that they are pronouncing their own "condemnation." In verse 7 the prophet suddenly drops the figurative language of the parable and addresses home the truth of its application to disobedient Israel in plain terms. The denunciation of the nation which follows in verses 8-30 contains six points or definite accusations expressed in the utterance of six woes, the first of which is contained in verses 8-10, which are not a part of the lesson text passage. Their first thrust is against the wealthy landowners who appropriate unto themselves the smaller properties of defenseless parties.

14. "Hell"—The place of the departed dead, the underworld. The sense of verse 14 is that death shall follow captivity as a culmination of the punishment of the disobedient people.

15. "Mighty"—The humiliation of high and low is one feature of Jehovah's judgment.

16. "That is holy shall be spottified in righteousness"—The righteousness of Jehovah's judgment is evident and his rule vindicated. His true nature as the Holy One of Israel is revealed. (Comp. Isa. 20, 25.)

17. "Strangers"—"Sojourners" (Marginal reading). The ray city with its population has vanished into the underworld, and the site of the city has become a grazing place for flocks—a figure of awful destruction rather than of "idyllic peace."

18. Verses 18 and 19 contain the third woe or threat which is against the mocking skepticism which leads men to harden themselves to sin. The figure of this verse seems to express a two-fold idea: (1) The determination on the part of men to deliberately work iniquity and (2) the inevitable judgment which must follow sin.

19. Men question God's very ability

to heed and punish. A strong picture of defiant unbelief so ripe in the political circles of Isaiah's time. (Comp. Isa. 35. 4-22; Jer. 5. 12 and 17. 15.)

20. In verses 20, 21 and 22 the fourth, fifth and sixth threats follow in quick succession. The fourth contained in verse 20, is against those who confuse moral judgments.

21. The fifth woe expressed in this verse is against the vain conceit of men. Possibly the threat was directed particularly against the politicians and corrupt statesmen.

22, 23. The sixth and last woe is against the dissolute and corrupt judges who, as well as others, indulge in drunkenness and forfeit their power of sober judgment. They are also directly accused of taking bribes.

Synopsis of Canadian Northwest HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

ANY even numbered section of Dominion lands in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 5 and 20, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of 160 acres in one or less.

Entry must be made personally at the local land office for the district in which the land is situated.

An homesteader is required to perform the conditions connected therewith under one of the following plans:

- (1) At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.
- (2) If the father or mother, if the father is deceased of the homesteader resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for the homestead as to residence may be satisfied by such person residing with the father or mother.
- (3) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicinity of the homestead, the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said land.

Six months' notice in writing should be given to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands Ottawa of intention to apply for patent.
