THE MATTER MAY BE ENQUIRED INTO.

LONDON, March 19.—It is evident from the attention being given in official circles to the New York Times interview with Ambassador Reid, in which the latter is quoted as saying that England today is in a condition similar to that which prevailed in France before the revolution in that country, that the matter will become a subject of official inquiry. One step has already been taken to ascertain if Mr. Reid was correctly quoted. As a result of a discussion in the lobbies of the house of commons, Sir Henry Dalziel, member for Kirkcaldy, gave notice of his intention to ask Sir Edward Grey, secretary of state for foreign affairs, whether his attention had been called to the interview which Mr. Reid has denied.
