### Used to Clear Fields of "Crash Birds"



A unit of famed peregrine falcons, favorites of ancient kings and their courts, have joined the royal air force The R. A. F. announced in London, Eng. that it had enlisted 15 falcions to clear the air near R.A.F. fields of birds during the winter months. It was pointed out that 13 planes have been involved in accidents resulting from flying into flocks of birds in England during the past year. Experiments conducted at one R. A. F. field indicated that a single falcon eliminated the bird menace with a few daily flights. Above is a peregrine falcon.

### Only Province Not Affected By Bacterial Rot

Prince Edward Island is the only Province in Canada whose potato industry is not affected by bacterial ring rot. Mr. S. G. Peppin, seed certification branch, Dominion Department of Agriculture, informed The Guardian yesterday.

This happy condition, Mr. Peppin said, was brought about by prompt, co-ordinated measures being taken by officers of both the Provincial and Dominion Departments of Agriculture when one small potato-growing section in the Province was found to have the disease. Immediately, spraying apparatus owned and operated by the Dominion Department of Agriculture in Charlottetown was taken to the infected farms. The cellars in all houses and buildings where potatoes had been stored were thoroughly sprayed with formaldehyde and bluestone as were all machinery, wagons, etc., that had been used in handling the potatoes. All bags used on the farm were destroyed.

Going a step further, Mr. Peppin said, the Provincial Government passed the Bacterial Ring Rot Act which makes it a legal offense for a farmer who, finding the disease in his field, does not notify the proper authorities at once. The Act also prohibits the importation into the Province of second-hand bags from any source whatsoever. Prince Edward Island is the only Province which has such legislation. Mr. Peppin said such precautions as those are partly responsible for the world-wide reputation enjoyed by P.E. Island seed potatoes.

### Declares Scotch Can Be Made Only In Scotland

WASHINGTON, Oct. 18 — (CP) — A spokesman for the makers of Scotch whisky today told the Justice Department Alcohol Unit that their product can be made only in Scotland. He said they don't want other producers to market an imitation with "Scotch" labels or decorations designed to mislead the buyer.

John Nicholson, who said he has been making Scotch for 52 years, appeared for the Scotch Whisky Association in protest against a request from American distillers for permission to market a product labelled "Scotch whisky made in the U. S. A."

No distillery outside Scotland has yet succeeded in producing a whisky indistinguishable from Scotch whisky, Nicholson told the Justice Department board.

He did not attack the kinds of whisky produced outside Scotland nor claim that Scotch was better or worse than any other kind, but maintained that no country other than Scotland can produce "Scotch whisky" just as Scotland can not produce Greek brandy.

Porter Chandler, an associate in the John W. Davis New York law firm which represents the Scotch Whisky Association, said a survey taken two years ago showed what he called "imitation" Scotch was passed off as the "genuine" article in more than 40 out of 100 retail purchases. He said the survey covered purchases of 800 bottles of whisky in 22 American cities.

Chandler put on the stand as witnesses at the opening of a three-day hearing on labelling requirements two Edinburgh whisky industry men who testified that the Scotch Scotch whisky over here now is mostly pre-war stuff at least seven years old and better aged than even the Scotch that father used to buy.

### Case Of Alleged Collaborators To Remain Closed

OTTAWA, Oct. 18 — (CP) — The case of the alleged Vichy collaborators so far as the Canadian Government is concerned, remains closed and will not be re-opened.

This was made clear today by Acting Prime Minister Howe when he told a Canadian Press reporter that the case was "officially closed" last night. He said the case was "closed as far as the Cabinet is concerned" and that it was his "strong impression" that the French Government has requested only the return of Count Jacques de Bernonville, now appealing a deportation order in Montreal.

Today, questioned about reports that the case would be reopened, he said: "I gave you a statement last night. I've checked it. It's true. That's the official story."

Other members of the Cabinet said they, too, understood that the case was closed. This indicated no action will be taken against the four Frenchmen, all reported to be living in Quebec Province, who were granted special Cabinet permission to live in Canada despite charges of collaboration with the wartime government of Vichy France. All four were convicted in absentia and one is understood to be under sentence of death.

Count de Bernonville was one of the original five who spirited their way into Canada over the last year under false passports. Like the other four, the Count sought permission to stay in Canada but was refused. Ordered deported, he now is fighting the deportation order in the Montreal courts.

There have been published reports that the French Government has asked Canada to evict the four men remaining here. Mr. Howe's statement that this was not so came from the French Embassy here. A spokesman said the Embassy had made no request for extradition, which he noted, ap-

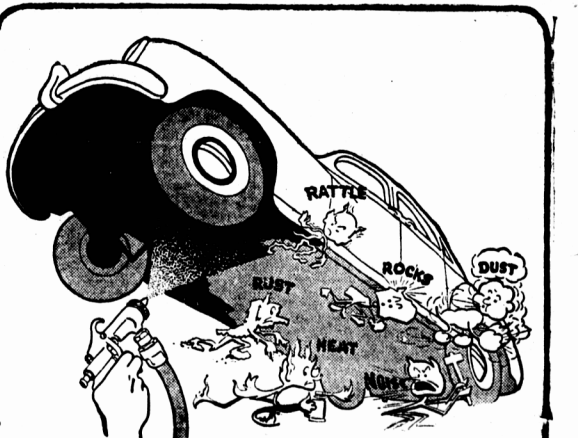
