Calves under six months \$15.00. Six to twelve months \$20.00. Twelve to eighteen months \$25.00. Eighteen to twenty-four months \$30.00. Two years and over \$35.00.

This assistance is open to any Island Farmer who, at time of purchase, has less than four registered Guernsey females.

As funds are limited, applications will be considered in the order received.
