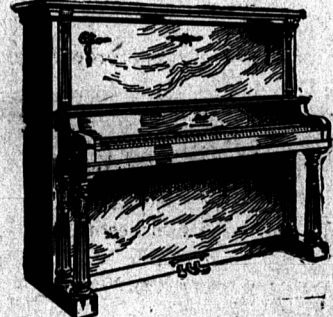

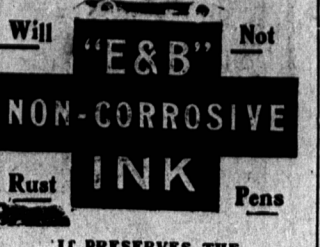

FIGHT IN SUBWAY TO CAPTURE THIEF

Broker Clings to Pick Pocket of International Reputation.

NEW YORK, April 7 (Special)—The experience of a young woman who caught a pickpocket in the Seventy-second street express station of the subway Tuesday night has been repeated, except on this occasion the capture was made by a man after a struggle which at times imperilled the lives of both. The man arrested was identified as a thief and pickpocket with an international record. Elias Frank, a real estate broker, of the Bronx, was changing from a local to an express train at the Seventy-second street station. Two men sprang in front of him and barred his entrance to the waiting express train. At the same time he felt the hand of another man dart swiftly into his trousers pocket, in which he had a wallet containing \$54 in cash and a check for \$50.

As soon as he trust his hand back to grab the hand in his pocket the two men who had darted in front of him grabbed his arms and raised them over his head. Then their confederate extracted the purse. Mr. Frank broke away from the two men and grabbed the man who had taken his purse. They fell to the platform together and rolled over and over. His prisoner threw the purse to one side, one of the others grabbed it and he and his companion jumped aboard a local train, which just had pulled into the station, and escaped.

FORDED, WADED, ROWED IN FLOODS TO MARRY

CHICAGO, April 1—Young Loch-invar had nothing on Orrie Gallup. He is a Purdue graduate and was married here yesterday. This is his speed story. His papa-in-law tells it: Orrie was in West Baden, Ind. On Saturday he went to the office of the Monon Railroad and informed that he was in Chicago by Monday. It was impossible then he said. Gallup offered to pay for a special train. The officers said the tracks had been washed out. Gallup got a horse and forded the Lost River at Orangeville. He rode the horse across two counties, sometimes through water to the stirrups, to Mitchell, Ind. He arrived at Mitchell just in time to catch a train for Seymour. At Seymour Gallup hired a boat and rowed several miles to a point where he was able to catch a train bound for Louisville, Kentucky. 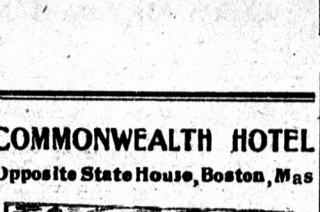
