Mr. Locke had just returned from working at the Market Building, just before 8 o'clock when he was assaulted. His room is on the third floor of the house. He told police he was struck from behind just as he entered the room. He thought for help and his assailant fled, at St. Dunstan's. Others in the house heard someone running down the stairs, but apparently no one saw the intruder. One woman said she thought she heard two pairs of footsteps.
