

A Toronto despatch says:—W. E. Stavert, the well known liquidator, who was employed in that capacity in the winding-up of the Ontario and Sovereign Banks, will shortly enter business in Montreal, relinquishing his Toronto connections. A despatch from Montreal mentioning his appointment to the Bank of Commerce staff was emphatically dated by this morning. He has been connected for many years with the Bank of Montreal.—(Mr. Stavert belongs to this province.)

A despatch from Montreal says:—Announcement made of the formation of the Montreal Bond Company Limited, which will be engaged in a general bond and investment business in the Canadian field. The company is now occupying temporary quarters in the Royal Insurance building, and will move into the new building in the City of Montreal in April. R. G. Muirhead will be manager of the new company, Mr. Muirhead is a New Brunswick by birth and was for a number of years in the service of the Royal Bank, but for the past three years has been connected with the firm of F. B. O'Carroll & Co., at their offices in Montreal and Halifax. The interests behind the Montreal Bond Company, it is understood, include C. H. Cahlan and H. A. Appleby, pastor of the Dartmouth Methodist Church, who recently received an invitation to accept the pastorate of one of the finest churches in Canada, at Saskatoon, Sask., will not go west this year, as intended.
