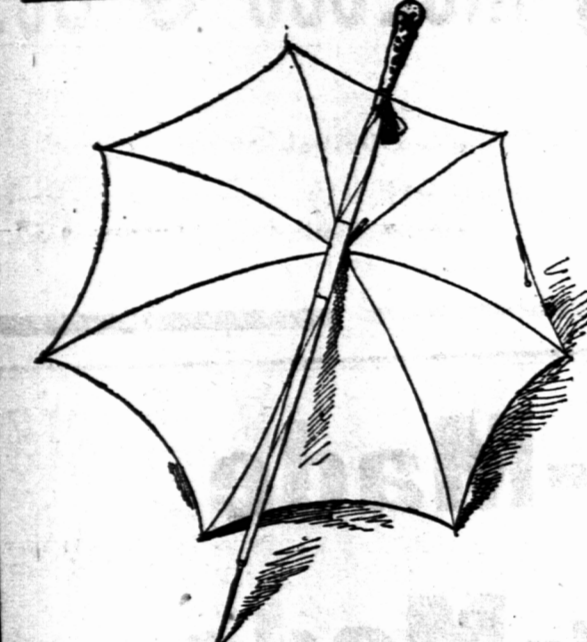

THE stake race for the champion stallion trotters in the Maritime Province, advertised, to take place in connection with the Nova Scotia Provincial Exhibition the entries of which were to be made on June 1st, did not fill. The race is declared off, but it has been re-opened for a purse of \$300, the entries to close on the 15th instant. "BETWEEN THE United States and the King's Dominion" is the attractive title of a picturesque, artistic and handsomely printed booklet published by the Plant Line and sent out by Manager H.L. Chipman. "Lights Along the Shore" from Massachusetts bay; on the coast of Nova Scotia and away on to Prince Edward Island furnish an interesting topic for several pages of this booklet. The delights of voyaging on the route of the Plant Liners between Boston, Halifax, Sydney and Charlottetown are well told, and prettily illustrated. Racy chapters are devoted to the attractiveness of the mainland of Nova Scotia, to Cape Breton, to Prince Edward Island, and lastly to "the ancient colony." As an appendix is a tabular list of the light-houses and a description of the lights along the route of the Plant line, and a map of the line's Boston, Nova Scotia, Cape Breton and Newfoundland route. The mileage is given as follows:—

Boston to Hawkesbury	569 miles
Boston to Halifax	389 miles
Boston to Charlottetown	663 miles
Halifax to Hawkesbury	180 miles
Halifax to Charlottetown	274 miles
Halifax to Sydney	286 miles
Hawkesbury to Charlottetown	94 miles
