That Body of Hours

When we think of all the people who had died following severe burns and know that now we are in possession of a form of treatment which prevents this terrible loss of life, we are indeed grateful.

This is due to the treatment of burns by tannic acid. Dr. P. H. Mitchener, London, tells us that during the period from 1929 to the present time, when tannic acid compresses have been used as the routine outpatient treatment for all burns and scalds no deaths have occurred among the slighter cases.

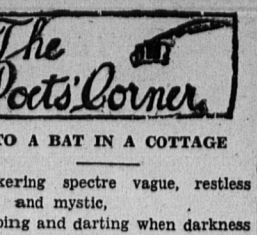

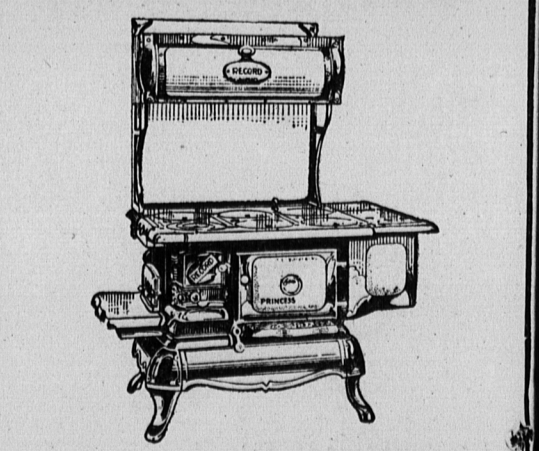
