FADED CURTAINS. If your curtains have faded, dissolve half a small packet of tartaric acid in cold water and rinse the curtains in this after washing; it seems to bring back the colors.

DROP-STITCH SCARF. Here is a clever way of making scarves for the Forces—and it is an excellent pattern for 3 or 4-ply wool. Using a set of four No. 3 needles, cast on 20 sts. on to three needles (60 sts. in all).

BEACH WEAR FOR THE PLUMP. For the large woman who wants to appear grounds slimmer than she really is, one-piece dressmaker bathing suits of wool jersey are a good choice.

HOUSEHOLD HINTS. If you have burned your frying pan or saucepan, try filling it with a strong solution of salt and water and let it stand a few hours.

HELPFUL HINTS For Campers. Do not sit or lie on bare ground; it is harmful and likely to cause sickness. It is better if caught out in the rain to sit on your hat and go bareheaded than to sit on the ground.

MENT JELLY FOR THE WINTER. Now that mint is getting plentiful it is a good plan to make a supply of mint jelly for winter use. Make up a lemon jelly in the usual way, using hot vinegar instead of water.

INK REMOVED FROM COTTON, silk or woolen goods by saturating the spots with spirits of turpentine. Let it remain several hours; then rub it between the hands. It will disappear, it is said, without injuring either the color or the texture of the article.

LIQUID MEDICINE. If it is a liquid medicine that has to be given you do not need to open his mouth at all. Raise the head quickly, incline it to one side, open the corner of the lips to make a sort of funnel, pour in the medicine, very gently keep his mouth closed and his head tilted upwards and wait for the swallow.
