

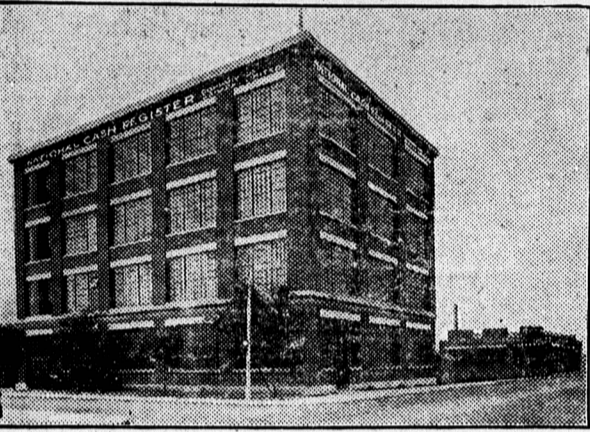


OLD TIME R. R. MAN SAYS IT IS GRAND
