A dealer at Summerside has just received a letter from a prominent Upper Province importer and wholesale dealer in produce asking to be put in touch with some reliable shipper or farmer who has one or more cars of really choice potatoes. The letter, however, concludes as follows: "I paid for potatoes from Prince Edward Island a year ago this fall, a total of \$35,276, but found after the drafts were paid, and when unloading from cars nearly all shipments were affected with field rot and dry rot. I sustained a very heavy loss, running up in the thousands of dollars, entirely owing to the bad quality. I want good, sound, white potatoes, smooth, well-assorted as to size and thoroughly matured."
